Laughlin Ranch has one of the newest and best golf courses in the Bullhead City area. The course is over 7000 yards, with 5 sets of tees and dramatic changes in elevation.

The Laughlin Ranch Golf Course is now home to the **Pinnacle Exceptional Drivers Championship**. Finals are held here each November. Local players can attempt to qualify for the finals in the

qualifying round held in September.

The Clubhouse at Laughlin Ranch includes an excellent lunch and dinner restaurant, a top-of-the-line "19th hole", workout facilities, and a swimming pool. The golf carts are equipped with air conditioning and GPS.

Reportedly, the developers would like to have the Laughlin Ranch golf course certified as a PGA course. This course is also reported to be one of 4 courses planned for the Laughlin Ranch development.

Laughlin Ranch is, without a doubt, the most awesome and awe-inspiring golf course in the area. From the #1 tee all the way through to #18, this course is a spectacular combination of fantastic western mountain and river scenery as well as intimidating fairways and greens. Watching the rabbits, quail and coyotes is just the icing on the cake. I played this course for the first time today in a foursome. On the first tee, we all unanimously exclaimed "wow!" Laughlin Ranch golf course is built on a mountain, so virtually every hole is either on a fairly steep up-slope or down-slope. Very impressive and worth every cent.

This is one gorgeous golf course! The panoramas are awesome. The course itself has 18 distinct holes, no two are alike. Each hole has its own "personality." This is not a course for the very timid player, but it is a lot of fun. The course has plenty of undulating fairways and greens, lush fairways, rough and tees, and more sand traps than I've seen on a single course around this area. Although the greens fees are a bit high, the opportunity to play this course, at least once, is worth every cent. Being one of the longer courses in the area, be sure to allow enough time to play all 18 holes! You don't want a mid- or late-afternoon tee time for Laughlin Ranch.
